**VFW Post 8545 Veterans Relief Fund Project: Veteran's Commemorative Brick**

**Criteria for Acquiring A Commemorative Brick:**

1. The individual must be on active duty or be a veteran of our U.S.A's military services, to include the Merchant Marine in an officially declared war, and
2. Veteran's service recognized by receipt of no less than a general discharge upon completion of service, and
3. Veteran has county as "home of record", or is resident of Isle of Wight County at time of acquiring commemorative brick thru this project, or
  - a. ...is buried in above named county or national veteran's cemetery, or
  - b. ...was resident of county at time of death, or
  - c. ...is a current or past member of Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 8545 and/or American Legion Post 49 .

**Commemorative Brick Cost**

\$125. This covers cost of brick, inscription thereon and placement in walk-way outside the Isle of Wight Veterans Memorial on N. Church St, in Smithfield, Virginia

**Inscription on Commemorative Brick**

1. Maximum of 13 characters per line, including punctuation and spaces
2. Maximum of 3 lines.....veteran's name on 1st and 2nd line, depending on # of characters, and branch of service on last line
3. Proper given names only....no nicknames will be used.
